Silver Cliff's Mining Heritage Days pull was held June 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> at the Silver Cliff City Park. This was our first activity at this location since the Town of Silver Cliff finished installing heavy wood fences on both sides of the pulling track. We appreciate the efforts the community makes to improve the event every year. Home made ice cream was again available (and popular) and we also had an exhibit of small farm items. Sunday afternoon was a bit windy. Results within.



## Royal Gorge Show

The annual show at the Royal Gorge Bridge & Park occurred in conjunction with Fathers Day weekend on June 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>. Club participation was down a little, but gate counts were good. 2120 people entered the park on Saturday and 3274 people came through the gates on Sunday. We had 15 tractors, trucks, and a horseless carriage on Saturday and ten motorized vehicles of one variety or another on Sunday.



We also had exhibits of tools, farm items, home-made ice-cream, a cider mill, and a hit-or-miss engine pumping water. One of the most unusual entries this year was a John Deere lawn tractor rigged to run on an electric motor which was recharged by solar panels. This conversion was done as a special project of the Canon City High School's automotive shop class. We appreciated having them bring it out to share it with us.

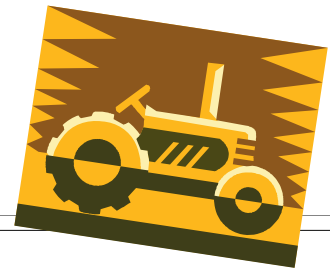

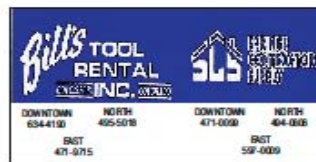
